New & Revitalized - RRC's Volunteer Management Certificate Program

Red River College, in collaboration with **Volunteer Manitoba** and **MAVA**, has completely reformatted and revitalized the Volunteer Management Certificate Program. These changes are significant and exciting. This program now makes it easier to obtain a solid foundation of skills and knowledge in the profession of Volunteer Management.

How Is The Program Different?

- * Changed Requirements - This certificate program is now comprised of 6 core courses (160 hours) focused on the employment requirements for a volunteer administrator, plus 72 hours of electives, totaling 242 hours.
- * Distance Education - You will be able to fulfill the entire program requirements regardless of where you live and you won't have to wait for a minimum number of students to take any of the courses or electives. In most cases, courses are also available through the classroom.
- * Practicum or Electives Option - an opportunity to put into practice what you learn right away by participating in a practicum or you can take electives totaling 72 credit hours.
- * Practicum Location - It is possible to do the practicum in your own agency (you must meet the criteria) so the agency and volunteers benefit from your education faster.

What Are The Core Courses?

You must take **Working With Volunteers** from RRC or ***Volunteer Management Introduction Level 1** from Volunteer Manitoba first. Then you can take the following courses in any order: Program Planning & Evaluation; Recruitment & Marketing; Training & Development; Interpersonal Communications; and Risk Management.
